KIDS | KID'S QUEST STUDENTS | THE ROCK DISABILITY MINISTRY | ACCESS

1. What is happening? In order to provide an even safer and more suitable environment to teach and encourage kids at McLean Bible Church, we are moving some of our programming locations as follows:

- Elementary Grades - ALL programming will now be on 1st Floor.
- K-1st will move to Community Rooms A and B (on 1st floor).
- Pre-School/Tree House will remain in the 1100s corridor.
- Nursery & Toddlers will remain in their locations near the 2nd Floor Cafeteria.
- Junior High Students (6th-8th grade) will now meet in the 1st Floor Gym.

2. Are these location changes permanent? Yes. While we still have a few more rooming adjustments to make in the near future, this largescale move is intended to be permanent.

3. Where do I check in now? There are 3 check-in areas: 1st Floor Smith Center Lobby, 2nd Floor Kid's Quest check in near the Cafeteria, and recently added 1st Floor near entrance door 1B. We encourage you to ask about self-check in if you're not yet familiar with it.

4. When is Kid's Quest programming happening? 9 am, 11 am, and 1 pm.

5. Is Kid's Quest or The Rock Student Ministry happening at the 5 pm service? No. Our very successful AWANA program will be offered on Sunday evenings for kids and students. Visitors are allowed to visit up to 3 times before deciding if they'd like to enroll. We will, however, still be offering nursery and toddler care during the 5 pm service.

6. What other additional security measures are you taking? In addition to consolidating our kids' areas for enhanced security, we are increasing and updating volunteer background checks, fingerprinting all volunteers and staff, and putting cameras in every kid space. We are trying to be as proactive as possible, and we will be working on these over the next several months.

7. What if I have a high school student? On Sunday mornings, we encourage high school students to attend a main service with their families and to find somewhere to serve during a second service. We also have great high school programming on Wednesday nights which include small groups. All other high school events, trips, and camps remain the same. We encourage you to visit The Rock Lounge on the 1st floor to find out how to get your high school student more involved! For more information about high school programming, please visit rockdc.com.

8. Where can I make suggestions for improvements? We will have large wall signs in several areas on the 1st floor where you may write your suggestions and ideas for how we can make the kids' area even better! We aren't finished yet!

9. Is Access Ministry moving? Friendship Club will be moving to the 1st Floor as well, but their new space is still being renovated. We will update Access participants as relocation time approaches.



BUILDING CHANGES AT MBC TYSONS SUNDAYS BEGINNING JAN. 14

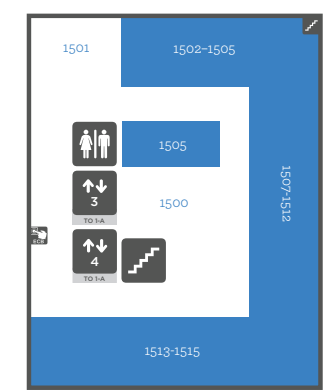
