"There is a danger signal at this point, a red light of caution that we must observe lest we fall into a serious heresy that is even now festering within the evangelical community. Though I am now indwelt by a Divine Being, by the Holy Spirit of God, I myself do not become a new incarnation of God. There are those who are teaching even now that a person who is indwelt by the Holy Spirit is as much the incarnation of God as Christ was. This is so grossly heretical and blasphemous... The Spirit works to produce sanctified human beings, not deified creatures." RC Sproul

"But if I know not the distinction between our working and the power of God, I know not God Himself. And if I know not God, I cannot worship Him, praise Him, give Him thanks, nor serve Him; for I shall not know how much I ought to ascribe unto myself, and how much unto God.
